Corbeau Seats Rally Tendring & Clacton 2022**

Stanley Graham reported that the rally will be along the same route as 2 years ago. Residents will receive a handbook again. The organisers are in the progress of generating a carbon offset programme, looking to offset around 110T of carbon, and they would like to do this locally.

The equestrian centre are planning on having an open day, which 'the rally' will support, in order to put something back to the village directly. Additionally 'the rally' will be supporting charities/organisations such as the RNLI and Air Ambulance,

They may be able to support a local scheme if we can provide a costed proposal that's relevant?

One of the difficulties in Wix is finding a spectator area.

Councillor queries:

KM-Given the rally passes immediately in front of resident's properties, with pedestrians lining the road (on private property), how is that risk assessed? Who risk assess it? Could we have a copy of the risk assessment?

SG-Will request the RA document from the committee.

There is a chicane before the first houses, which does slow them down but they pick up speed straight after.

MB- The carbon offset. He would like to see that calculated. Is it direct or indirect emissions; just the race, or spectators travelling to see it.

Gt Oakley chair- Electric cars- why aren't they being used? This should be considered.

SG-Motorsport UK does have the rules in place for electric cars, but there are issues at this stage.

The council thanked Stanley for his time, and will be in touch with any further queries.
