# 22/102 Clerks Report

The replacement bins are being processed. We are waiting for permission to use the piece of grass next to the play area, owned by the Village Hall, and highways, for the Clacton Road and Bradfield Road sites. The gym equipment surfacing has now been installed.

#### 22/103 Speaker- Adam Brown, applicant for planning app 22/00820/FUL

Mr Brown was available to answer questions on the application for 3 additional poultry houses at Treestacks Farm on Oakley Rd.

A number of comments and questions were raised by councillors and the public. Key points:

• There are 2 existing sheds, and have been a number of subsequent applications, and now an application for additional 3 sheds. During the initial application, expansion was 'not being considered by the applicant'. Mr Brown couldn't recall saying there wouldn't be expansion. They didn't know where the venture would end up taking them, however he apologised for the misunderstanding.

- The site has got capacity for more sheds. Concerned about creeping development
- Mr Brown was asked about the additional traffic movements as this is a major concern for the parish council, and he advised the council to check the Traffic Statement in the planning application
- What benefits does the chicken farm bring to the village?

Employment (there is a village resident employed by the farm), and employee's use of the village shop.

The parish council thanked Mr Brown and Mr Bishop for their time. Councillors will discuss the application and make recommendations under item 22/104
