Sue Lusher- appendix 1 Report from Sue Lusher regarding damage caused by vehicles during A120 road closures.

Mark De Roy- As part of the work investigation work being carried out on his land, Mr De Roy has suggested that the 30mph signs (and limit) be moved further west, on Colchester Rd. He is discussing options with a planning advisor and is willing to put in a request to Essex Highways, for the extension. He is also willing to cover the admin cost.

Mr De Roy would seek support from the PC for this, and will send full details in due course.

Bradley Bone- Regarding the ditch and PRoW, adjacent to the school, Essex Highways are unable to and will not do anything.

Chris Swinburn- Bowl Rd- Mr Swinburn raised a number of issues,

- 1) Hazardous waste disposed on Bowl Road. He has spoken to Matthew Leach (TDC), to arrange a street clean and raise his concerns regarding the hazardous waste (urine bottles)
- 2) Empty Alcohol bottles on Bowl Road. He retrieved 72 this morning. Issue to be passed to the police
- 3) Solar Farm- planning permission for the Solar Farm. Number of issues including access and movement conditions not being complied with. They are also not using the designated access on Bowl Road, which has been blocked off with a tree, so they are driving past the house.

Cllr Stephens will advise Mr Swinburn on who to write to regarding this issue

Calvin Pallace- Maintenance issues regarding the road signage coming into the village. Calvin also raised concerns regarding speeding on Harwich Rd. It was agreed to have an agenda item at the next meeting to discuss an LHP application for a VAS sign. (Vehicle Activated Speed sign)
